P R E F A C E.

The previous edition of the By-Laws having long been out of print, I have thought it expedient to compile the present edition, in which I have ventured to make a few additions and alterations.

(1). I have recast the History of the Lodge, continuing it to the present time.

(2). I have omitted the List of Members of the Lodge who have served the Office of Stewards of the

Masonic Charities for the Province of Oxfordshire. This information can easily be obtained from the Oxfordshire Freemasons' Calendar.

(3). I have discontinued the dia-critical marks formerly attached to the names of Subscribing and Honorary Life Members. These two classes are so fluctuating, that any information of the kind rather tends to mislead than to inform.

(4). I have introduced two lists : one of Members who have served Office in Grand Lodge, the other of Members who have been Officers of the Provincial Grand Lodge of Oxfordshire.

I have to express my acknowledgment to the Deputy Provincial Grand Master, whose courtesy has placed at my disposal the information which in his long and zealous Masonic service he has acquired.

HISTORY
OF THE
APOLLO UNIVERSITY LODGE.

LODGE OF
ALFRED, 1769.

The first mention of a Lodge in the University of Oxford is found in a petition addressed to the Duke of Beaufort, the Grand Master, dated 21st November, 1769. In consequence of this petition, the Lodge of Alfred in the University of Oxford, No. 155, was constituted, and held its meetings first at the King's Head in the Corn-market and afterwards at the New Inn in Fish Street, now St. Aldate's

Street. The Lodge of Alfred ceased to work in 1783 and no University Lodge existed in Oxford from that date until the year 1819, when

LODGE. Brothers Daniel Keyte Sandford of Christ Church, James Edmund

Leslie of Christ Church, Lambert Blackwell Larking of Brasenose, William John St. Aubyn of Worcester, and George Hitchings, the W.M. of the Alfred Lodge, 649, having obtained the Vice-Chancellor's permission to found a Lodge in the University, received from the Duke of Sussex, Grand Master, a Warrant dated 21st December, 1818, constituting the Apollo Lodge, No. 711 on the Registry of the Grand Lodge of England, and appointing Bro.

John Ireland, P.M. of Lodges 96 and 649, Worshipful Master, and Bro. George Hitchings, W.M. of 649 and Bro. Sir Charles Macdonald Lockhart, Bart. Wardens.

OPENING OF LODGE. The Lodge was opened on the 10th February, 1819, at the Star Hotel (now the Clarendon), but the installation of the W.M. did not take place till the 18th and the appointment of the Officers was not made till the 19th of February, which day has since been always considered the anniversary of the Lodge. The List of

Officers was as follows:

CHANGE OF
NAME.

In the first year of its existence an application was made that the Lodge should be designated the Apollo University Lodge. Permission having been granted by the Grand Lodge, the title as amended appeared in the Freemasons' Calendar for 1820 and succeeding years, but the original name continued to be used in the minutes until December the 6th, 1826.

CHANGES OF
NUMBER.

In 1832 the number of the Lodge was changed from 711 to 460, and in 1863 from 460 to 357.

**DAYS OF
 MEETING.**

Lodges were originally held on the first Wednesday of every month during Term. The meetings took place subsequently on the first and third Wednesdays; but after returning to the original system for a short time, it was finally arranged that the Lodge should meet on the last Wednesday in every month during Term, except in the months of January and April, when the last Tuesday was to be the day of meeting.

FESTIVALS.

Two festivals were formerly observed in the year, one in November when the Master for the ensuing year was elected and the other on the anniversary of the Lodge. The former

of these festivals has long been discontinued.

OLD BY-LAWS. Among the old resolutions and By-Laws of the Lodge we find the following: "On account of keeping the goodwill of the Vice-Chancellor and Proctors, the Members of the Lodge shall proceed to the meetings in Academics." It also appears that Fines were imposed on Brethren who did not come till supper time and on those who did not appear in full dress or who did not wear white gloves.

**PROPOSED
BY-LAW.**

A by-law proposed in 1853 "that henceforth no one shall be proposed for this Lodge except he be or has been a Member of this University"

was not confirmed by the Provincial Grand Master ; but the restriction has been practically maintained.

CHANGES
OF PLACE OF
MEETING TO
ANGEL HOTEL:

In 1829 the place of meeting was changed from the Star to the Angel Hotel in the High Street, and a few meetings were subsequently held at the Maidenhead in Turl Street.

TO THE MASONIC
HALL, ALFRED
STREET.

In 1833 the Masonic Hall in Alfred Street was erected and the Lodge was removed thither and there held its meetings for more than thirty years.

THE UNIVERSITY
MASONIC HALL;

On the 4th of August, 1864, the foundation of the University Masonic Hall in

Frewen Court, Cornmarket Street, especially reserved to the use of the Apollo University Lodge, was laid in due masonic form by Alderman R. J. Spiers, F.S.A., D.P.G.M. in the absence of the Provincial Grand Master, and on the 24th of February, 1865, the Building
 was solemnly consecrated
 ITS CONSECRATION. and dedicated to the purposes of antient free-masonry by Lieut.-Col. H. A. Bowyer, M.A., B.N.C., the Provincial Grand Master.

THE SEMI-CEN-TENARY

On the 19th of February in the present year (1869), the Fiftieth Anniversary of the Lodge was celebrated.

THE APOLLO
ROYAL ARCH
CHAPTER.

On the 28th of May,
1869, a Royal Arch
Chapter, named the
Apollo University Chapter and at-
tached to the Lodge, was consecrated
by the Most Excellent Companion
R. J. Spiers, in the absence of
Lieut.-Col. Bowyer, Provincial Grand
Superintendent of Oxfordshire.

BY-LAWS
OF THE
APOLLO UNIVERSITY LODGE,
No. 357,

APPROVED BY LIEUT.-COL. H. A. BOWYER,
PROVINCIAL GRAND MASTER OF OXFORDSHIRE.

1. The regular meetings of this Lodge shall be held on the last Wednesday of every month during Term, except in the months of January and April, when they shall be held on the last Tuesday.

2. The Anniversary Festival shall take place on the 19th of February in every year or about that time on a day fixed by the Worshipful Master.

3. Every gentleman desirous of being initiated into Masonry in this Lodge must be proposed in open lodge by one member and seconded by another. His proposer shall deliver to the Secretary the Christian and surnames, age and college of the candidate. On the Lodge night immediately following a ballot shall take place, and the candidate shall be elected, unless one black ball appear if ten or a less number of members, two, if twenty members be present. Three black balls shall exclude under any circumstances.

A candidate so elected may be initiated at the next meeting of the Lodge or at any subsequent meeting within three months, but the Worshipful Master may at his discretion

initiate him on the evening of his election.

4. Any brother who shall have been initiated in another Lodge and shall be desirous of becoming a member of this Lodge shall be proposed and balloted for, as in By-Law 3.

5. The fees payable shall be:

These fees shall be paid to the Secretary in the Lodge, to the Treasurer

or to the account of the Apollo University Lodge at the Old Bank and a printed form of receipt shall be given.

6. Every gentleman initiated in this Lodge and every brother who joins it shall on his initiation or reception pay the usual fees and his proposer shall be answerable for the payment.

7. Every Member of this Lodge shall pay annually the sum of three guineas ; one on the first Lodge night in Lent Term, one on the first in Easter Term and one on the first in Michaelmas Term, but if after subscribing for two years he continues to reside in Oxford he shall subscribe one guinea annually in advance.

8. Any Member after subscribing two full years shall be at liberty to become an honorary member on payment of five guineas, or if non-resident a subscribing member on payment of half-a-guinea annually in advance, but if any such member, after being applied to by the Secretary, shall neglect to pay his subscription, his name shall be erased from the list of members. No brother shall be at liberty to withdraw his name from the Lodge until all arrears are paid and notice in writing has been given to the Secretary or Treasurer.

9. At the regular Lodge held on the last Wednesday in November a Worshipful Master and Treasurer shall be elected by ballot and a Tyler by show of hands. The Master so elected,

after his election has been duly confirmed, shall appoint his Wardens, Chaplains, Secretary, Deacons, Masters of the Ceremonies, Inner Guard, Organist and Stewards, who shall be installed in their respective offices on the anniversary Festival.

10. The Treasurer shall produce on the first Lodge night in Term an account of the funds, receipts and disbursements of the Lodge.

11. Every Officer of this Lodge is required to attend punctually on the Lodge nights or to give due notice to the Worshipful Master on occasions of unavoidable absence.

12. Refreshment shall be served immediately after the Lodge closes

and generally the brethren shall disperse at eleven o'clock. The Worshipful Master may however at his discretion permit them to remain until ten minutes before midnight.

13. For every visiting brother a fee of ten shillings and sixpence shall be paid, but the Worshipful Master shall be empowered to invite visitors to supper without fees.

14. The Treasurer shall produce on a specified day in Lent Term, to be fixed by the Worshipful Master, a statement of the accounts of the Lodge before a Committee, consisting of the Worshipful Master, Past Masters, Wardens and Secretary. Three of the number shall at any time form

a quorum. The accounts so audited shall be printed and a copy sent to every member of the Lodge.

15. The pay of the Tyler shall be five shillings per night, which sum shall include remuneration for his attendance at supper.

16. The cash, jewels, furniture, &c. of the Lodge shall be vested in and deemed the property of the Master and Wardens for the time being, in trust for the members of the Lodge.

17. The Worshipful Master of the Isaac Newton Lodge is *jure dignitatis* an Honorary Member of the Lodge and his Wardens shall be admitted as Honorary Members during their year of office.

18. A printed copy of these By-Laws with a list of the Members of the Lodge and a copy of the Book of Constitutions shall be delivered to every brother on his initiation or reception.
